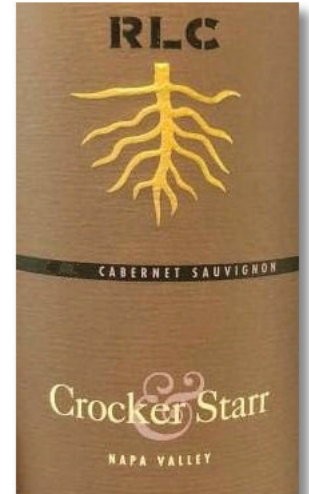


CLUB CRUSH CABERNET *June Shipment (#3 - 2020)*

CROCKER & STARR **2015 'RLC' CABERNET SAUVIGNON** **ST. HELENA, NAPA VALLEY**

In 1997, Charlie Crocker and Pam Starr established Crocker & Starr with a common goal of resurrecting the historic Crocker Vineyard Estate and creating world-class wines from its extraordinary terroir. The philosophy at Crocker & Starr is to capture the greatness of the Crocker Vineyard in powerful and balanced wines without compromise, striving to set the bar for St Helena Appellation Cabernets as a First Growth Bordeaux Chateau would.

Named for the variations of rock, loam, and clay soils found throughout the Crocker Vineyard, RLC is the embodiment of Crocker & Starr as a concept. RLC is the third distinctive estate Cabernet Sauvignon from the St Helena based Crocker Estate. The varying soil compositions in these vine blocks yield generous and supple grapes which in turn yield a plush and classic Cabernet Sauvignon wine.

TASTING NOTES: Deep garnet-purple colored, it sings of crushed black cherries, mulberries and cassis with lovely lilacs and cedar notions plus wafts of spearmint and milk chocolate. Medium to full-bodied, firm and grainy, with oodles of crunchy fruit, it has a long, fragrant, earthy finish.

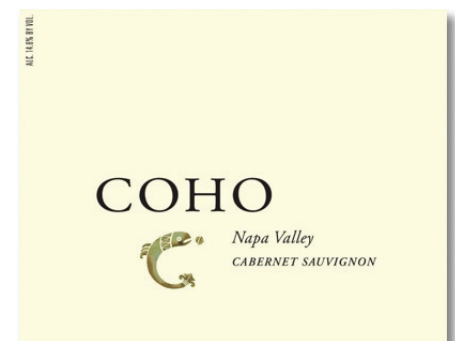

COHO WINES **2015 CABERNET SAUVIGNON** **NAPA VALLEY**

This Cabernet Sauvignon was grown on the prestigious Sugarloaf East Vineyard on a hillside southeast of downtown Napa. The Petit Verdot is from the Chinn Vineyard in Coombsville.

TASTING NOTES: The cool climate setting for both vineyards elicits spicy nuances in the aromatics and on the palate, while the lively black cherry, cassis and licorice flavors are underlain by silky, resolved tannins. The 2015 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a lovely, elegant wine already revealing its charms, but will continue to develop complexity and finesse as it ages.
