ELEPHANT SEVEN 2018 BLUE MOUNTAIN VINEYARD VIOGNIER WALLA WALLA VALLEY, WASHINGTON

Founded in 2014, Elephant Seven is a family-owned, boutique winery focusing on Rhone varietals from the Walla Walla Valley. With a minimalist winemaking philosophy, Elephant Seven prides itself on making wine that has a distinct sense of place. They currently produces 1,000 cases of wine per year.

TASTING NOTES: Aromatics of exotic flowers, orange blossom, and mint jump from the glass. A light to medium bodied mid-palate with green apple and apricot unfolds to reveal an abundance of stony minerality and brininess, nervy tension and bright acidity. The zesty finish lingers nicely with just a touch of citrus peel.

LICHEN ESTATE 2018 PINOT GRIS ANDERSON VALLEY, MENDOCINO

A 203-acre estate in the heart of the Anderson Valley, Lichen is everywhere in the valley and the farm was named “Lichen” in honor of its beauty and grace. Originally known as Breggo Cellars, which was founded in 2005 and sold in 2009, Lichen Estate Vineyard was planted in 2008. By 2014 Lichen’s first estate grown wines were released. They produce both still and sparkling Pinot Noir as well as Pinot Gris and a Blanc de Gris.

TASTING NOTES: Our 2018 Pinot Gris offers Lichen’s richest take yet on this dazzlingly aromatic varietal. Opulent and ripe fruit abounds, yet the wine remains jazzy and refreshing. Clocking in at 13.7% alcohol, it strays from our more restrained prior vintages, but it’s been a crowd pleaser in the tasting room.

TASTING NOTES: Aleatico is a Corsican black muscat variety, once the favorite wine of Napoleon Bonaparte. We’ve put a new twist on it by making it a dry aromatic white wine. Honey in color, with a full range of aromatics including nutmeg, ripe peaches and honeysuckle. Pleasantly dry and crisp. It is approachable and must be tasted to be believed.
