ELK COVE VINEYARDS 2017 PINOT NOIR GOODRICH VINEYARD YAMHILL-CARLTON, WILLAMETTE VALLEY

Elk Cove Vineyards is one of Oregon's historic family-owned wineries and was founded in 1974 by Pat and Joe Campbell. Second-generation winemaker Adam Campbell produces excellent Single Vineyard Pinot Noirs as well as crisp aromatic Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc and Riesling with an emphasis on estate-grown fruit.

The Goodrich Vineyard is a 69 acre property planted with 21 acres of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, Goodrich Road sits just outside the town of Yamhill, Oregon in the heart of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. Goodrich Vineyard was planted in 2007 with Chardonnay and Pinot Noir in high-density a format. The property boasts marine sediment (Willakenzie) soil and lies just a few miles from our Estate Vineyard in Gaston.

TASTING NOTES: Aromas of prosciutto, crushed black berries and black cherries plus notes of cinnamon stick, dried leaves, potpourri and sweet spice. It's medium-bodied with good intensity, a firm frame and long, fresh finish.



PEAKE RANCH 2017 PINOT NOIR STA RITA HILLS

Located on the eastern end of the Sta. Rita Hills AVA on Santa Rosa Road, Peake Ranch is a 105-acre parcel with 50 acres of vines. The plantings include seven different clones of Pinot Noir, three clones of Chardonnay and two each of Syrah and Grenache.

The winery is named after artist and avid rancher Channing Peake, whose family owned the property known as Rancho Jabali until Richard Sanford bought the property in 1982. In 2013, Robert Zorich bought half of the ranch, including the El Jabali Vineyard, when he assumed ownership of Alma Rosa.

The other half, which includes the landmark tasting shack, was purchased by John and Gillian Wagner and is now Peake Ranch.

TASTING NOTES: A compelling example of what can be achieved with Pinot Noir from Santa Rita Hills, this wine captures the natural balance and complexity of this special appellation. The aromas blend bright cherries and blueberries with a subtle and distinguished earthiness expressed as dried oregano, white pepper and black tea. An engaging, seductive texture is supported with a backbone of French oak and finely-grained tannins.
